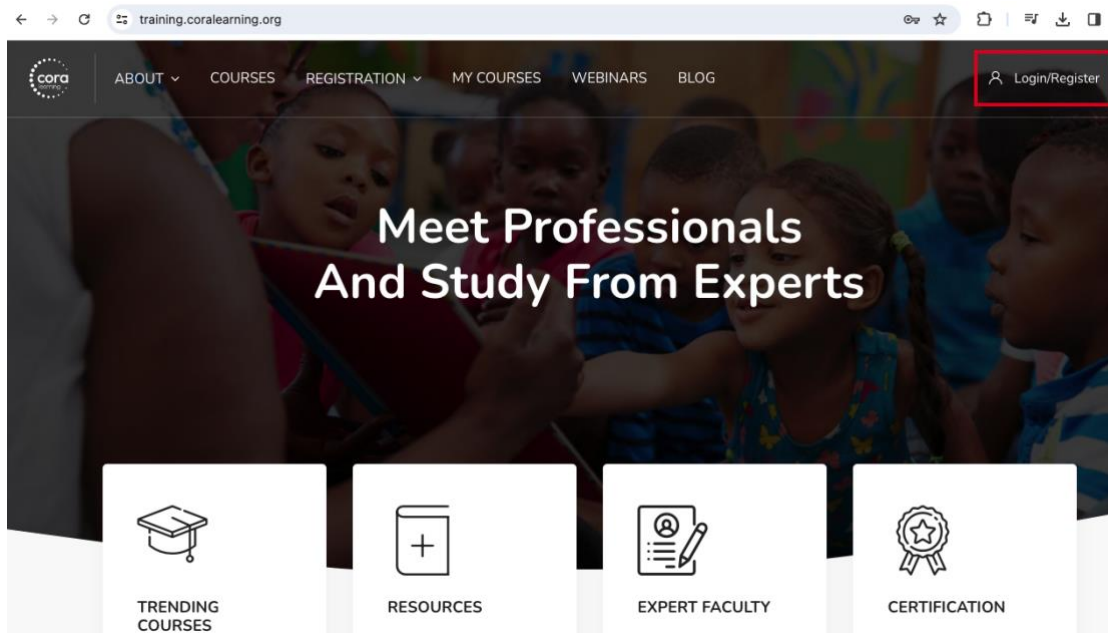


Picture guide on how to navigate through the CORA Training Program

1. Login:

Go to <https://training.coralearning.org/> and click on login at the top right corner of the home page.




Once one clicks on the Login/Register, there will be a pop-up that will ask for a username and password—please login using your credentials.

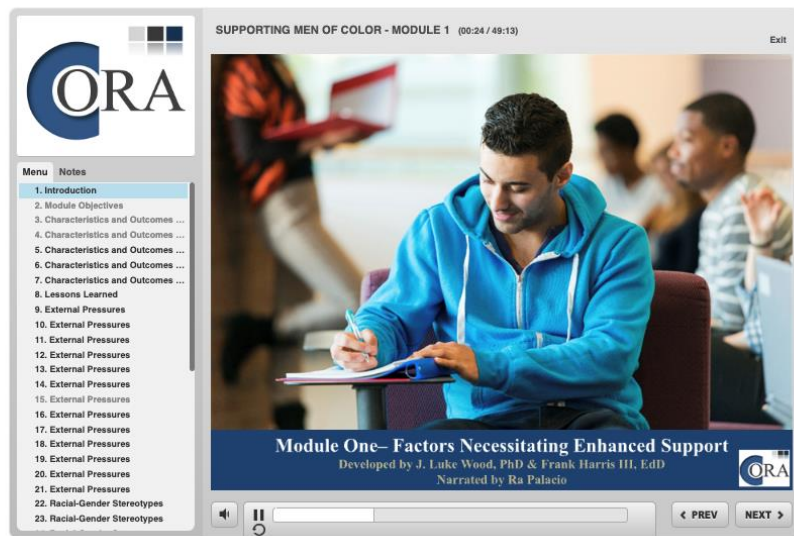
To maximize the video screen, click to hide the review panel.
